

Semester Exam Project – Video Lesson—EXTRA CREDIT

To begin rounding out the semester, your assignment will be to make a Show Me video lesson based upon one of the topics that you learned this school year (so far). Below are the guidelines for the instructional video.

Your instructional video must:

- Be at least six minutes in length, and no longer than ten minutes
- Be engaging
- Introduce the specific topic, the required content and information regarding the content, and where they fall in Algebra II.
- Teach at least two problems of varying difficulty
- Incorporate an application of real life (How could you use this outside of school?)
- Include practice problems for the viewer to try on their own with answers/solutions included.

You may work individually or in a group, but the group maximum is three. Each person's contribution to the group must be clear.

Choose problems from the exam review! Do not choose problems that were easy for you! Choose problems that made you think!!

You may record the videos however you would like, but iPads will be provided for you during class and school hours. They will not be available for check out, and you will not be able to take the iPads out of the classroom. You may bring in your own iPad to use. Email me a copy of your video(s).
